The dance is from the city of Artvin and the song is from the border to Kars, known as a Kars tune. It is in the Horon style.

Pronunciation:	Ooch kiz beer ah-nuh
Translation:	Three girls (daughters in this case) and a mother
Music:	10/8 meter (12 123 12 123) = (ct 1, ct &, ct 2, ct &)
Formation:	Semi-Circle
Steps & Styling:	Semi-Circle, facing center, arms bent from elbows, in W position.
Introduction:	One turn of the melody

1	S	Upper body faces center, lower body moves to LOD, step R to R
2, &	QQ	Step L across R (ct. 2), step R to R (&)
3	S	Step L across R
4,&	QQ	Step R to R (ct. 4), step L across R (ct. &)
5	S	Step back on R turning to face center
6, &	QQ	Step L in place in front of R (ct. 6), step R in place behind L (ct. &)
7	S	Step L in place in front of R
8, &	QQ	Touch R toe in front of L (ct. 8), lift R and pump it down, lowering arms* (ct. &)
9, &	QQ	Step R slightly bkwds from center, moving arms* fwd (ct. 9), lift L up and pump it down, moving arms* bkwd (ct. &)
10, &	QQ	Repeat ct. 9, & with opposite footwork
11, &	QQ	Repeat ct. 9, &
12	S	Step L beside R, raising arms* to W position.

- 1, & QQ Step on R heel to R (ct. 1), slide L behind R to R bending both knees (ct. &)
- 2, & QQ Repeat ct 1, &
- 3 S Step R to R bringing L foot from behind.
- 4, & QQ Touch L toe across R (ct 4), lift L up and gently pump it, lowering arms* (ct &)
- 5, & QQ Step L slightly bkwds from center, moving arms* fwd (ct 5), lift R up and pump it down, moving arms* bkwd (ct &)
- 6, & QQ Repeat ct. 5, & with opposite footwork.
- 7, & QQ Repeat ct. 5, &
- 8 S Cross R in front of L and touch R toe in front of L toe, raising arms* to W position.
