

# Bre Devojče

<b>Origin:</b>	Serbian dance from Kosovo region
<b>Translation:</b>	Hey Girl
<b>Pronunciation:</b>	BREY duh-voi-chey
<b>Formation:</b>	Open circle facing the center with arms in “W” position
<b>Style:</b>	All movements are done with a slight bounce by bending knees gently
<b>Meter:</b>	2/4

Introduction: Start with arms down. Raise hands on 8<sup>th</sup> count, then start dance with singing.

## Meas FIGURE 1

- 1 Step on L to center (ct 1); Touch R toe beside L (ct 2)
- 2 Step on R slightly diagonal R while arms move to right (ct 1); Step on L behind R while arms move to left (ct 2)
- 3 Step R to R (ct 1); Touch L beside R (ct 2)

Repeat Figure 1 for a total of 11 times.

When men start singing, finish Figure 1, then start Figure 2.

## Meas FIGURE 2

- 1 Step on L toward center but slightly diagonally to R (ct 1), step on R beside L (ct &), step fwd on L (ct 2)
- 2-3 Same as Figure 1 meas 2-3

Repeat Figure 2 for a total of 5 times. Switch back to Figure 1 at music change.

Repeat Figure 1 for 5 times.

End of dance: Step on L beside R, putting wt on both feet, and bring arms gently fwd & down.
