1	Step on L ft, turning to face L (1), step on R ft crossing in front of L ft, with R arm coming downward across body, while L arm is down (2)
2	Facing ctr, step on L ft in place (1), step on R ft next to L (2)
3	Facing and travelling LOD, step on L ft (1), step on R ft (2)
4	Still facing LOD, small hop on R ft, simultaneously clapping both hands in front (1), step back onto L ft (2)
5	Still facing LOD, step fwd on R ft (1), step fwd on L ft turning to face ctr (2
5	Facing ctr, step on R ft to R (1), step on L ft next to R (2)
7-8	Facing ctr, ft together, clap both hands like in meas. 9-10 of introduction: Q
