LES BREBIS

(French-Canada)

Traditional dance from the Acadian region of Prince Edward Island, Eastern Canada.

Translation : The sheep	
Formation:	4 cpls in a square formation. Cpl #1 has back to music. Cpl #2 is to right of Cpl #1.
	Cpl #3 is opposite Cpl #1. Cpl #4 is to left of Cpl #1.
Meter :	2/4
Music:	Yves and France Moreau CD

Dance does not follow music exactly.

Counts here are a guide only and are approximately the counts done at Lyrids. Music has 64 x 8 ct phrases.

Introduction

- 1. Bow to partner (8 cts), bow to corner (8 cts)
- 2. Circle to L halfway (8 cts), circle to R back to place (8 cts)
- 3. Swing partner (16 cts)
- 4. Promenade in LOD (16 cts)

Main Figure

- 5. **Cpl#1** forms a small circle travelling L with **cpl #2** (8 cts)
- 6. **Cpl #1 & cpl #2** form a circle with **cpl #3** (8 cts)
- 7. M #1 opens the circle and leads the line around W#4 then around M#4 (32 cts)
- 8. **Cpl #1, cpl #2** and **cpl #3** form a circle travelling RLOD around **cpl#4** who during that time swings in the middle (8 cts)
- 9. Cpl#4 continues to swing while cpl #1, cpl #2 and cpl #3 travel in LOD (8 cts)
- 10 Everybody swings home (8 cts)

Transition

11. Promenade in LOD (16 cts)

REPEAT Main Figure and Transition with cpls #2, #3, #4 who each has a turn to be active

Finale

- 12. Facing partner, grand right and left back to original place and original partner (32 cts)
- 13. Swing partner (8 cts)
- 14. Promenade in LOD (16 cts)
- 15 All join hands in a circle and go fwd & back, twice (16 cts)
- 16. Everyone **clap their hands** if there is music left
