This dance is named after, and originally performed by the *Sarakatsani*, also called *Karakacani* (Каракачани) in Bulgaria.

The Sarakatsani are an ethnic Greek population group (Σαρακατσάνοι), who were traditionally shepherds, native to Greece, with a smaller presence in neighboring, southern Albania and the Republic of Macedonia. The vast majority of the Sarakatsani have currently abandoned the nomadic way of life and have been urbanized to a significant degree.

There have been various theories about the origin of the name *Sarakatsani*. According to the most popular one, the name derives from the Turkish *kaçan*, meaning "black" or "fugitive" The Ottomans also use the Turkish word *karakaçan* (from *kara*) in reference to those people who were dressed in black and were fleeing in the mountains during the Ottoman occupation of Greece. According to another theory, the name derives from the village of *Sakaretsi*, the supposed homeland of the *Sarakatsani*.

ORIGIN & STYLE:

This original variant of Karakacansko Horo is very popular at the yearly Karakachanski Festival and Greek New Year's celebrations in Bulgaria. More recently the dance is also been adopted in Bulgaria in the so called *Horoteka* - repertoire. The dance shows similarities with the authentic greek dances Itia and Sirtos. The performance style is fluent with small and bouncy steps.
